# TREATING & PREVENTING DIABETES COMPLICATIONS

The complications for type 1 and type 2 diabetes are the same. Diabetes is the leading cause of kidney failure, blindness, nerve damage, amputation, heart attack, stroke and pregnancy complications. People with diabetes are two-four times more likely to have a heart attack or stroke than people without the disease.

Despite significant advances in blood sugar (blood glucose) level monitoring and insulin therapy, people with diabetes spend significant portions of the day with too high levels of blood glucose, placing them at risk for the development of diabetes complications.

*JDRF Complications Prevention Research focuses on ways to free people from the devastating long-term complications of diabetes.*

# WHAT IS DIABETES?

## DIABETES IS A CHRONIC, DEBILITATING DISEASE AFFECTING EVERY ORGAN SYSTEM

Type 1 diabetes (T1D) is an autoimmune disease in which the pancreas stops producing insulin, a hormone that enables people to get energy from food. T1D is more commonly diagnosed in childhood, adolescence, or young adulthood and lasts a lifetime.

Type 2 diabetes is a metabolic disorder in which the pancreas still produces some insulin but is unable to utilize it effectively. Type 2 does not always require insulin injections, however, almost 40% of type 2s are insulin dependent.

While patients with T1D have a rapid onset and sudden dependence on insulin, patients with Latent Autoimmune Diabetes in Adults (LADA) gradually become insulin dependent. LADA, like T1D, is an autoimmune disease which can not be prevented with diet and exercise.
